Step 1: Log In to Healthstream

You will log in to Healthstream to complete your online safety education assignments using the same user ID and password you created previously.

• Navigate to https://www.healthstream.com/hlc/phs

Step 1a: Enter Login ID and password you created then click "Sign In".

Step 1b: Once logged in, click continue to be taken to your "To Do" list. Assignments works best on PC computers in Internet Explorer 11.

Step 2: If Your Password is Expired

If your password is expired and you remember your old password you can change your password using the following method:

Navigate to https://citrixapps.providence.org

Step 1a: Enter Login ID and old password then click "Log On"

Step 1b: You will get a message saying your password has expired. Enter a new password and submit.

Step 1c: Repeat step 1b.

Step 1d: You will get a message saying access **denied** – **IGNORE** this statement. You have now successfully changed your password.

Providence Password Requirements:

- Minimum 8 characters
- The password must contain 3 out of 4 of the following:
 - 1. Lower case letters (a z)
 - 2. Upper case letters (A Z)
 - 3. Digits (0 9)
 - 4. Special characters (~!#\$\%^&*_-+=`|\(){}[]:;"'<>,.?/@)
- You cannot reuse previous passwords
- Proper names cannot be used

Step 3: If you have not yet set up Personal Identifiers

Security Questions (aka Personal Identifiers/PIDs) will be used to verify identity for password assistance if a call to the Service Desk is required. You will need to create your Security Questions and Answers. Use the following web site: https://appsor.providence.org/pid/ to do so.
